The museums quarter is wheelchair accessible. Sites are all level access and have lifts, however, some parts of the upstairs of Wilberforce House Museum are only accessible by stairs.

High Street is a cobbled street with a paving stone pavement. It has dropped kerbs at the Museums Quarter entrances. An accessible map of High Street can be downloaded below.

A small number of portable fold- out stools will be available to borrow from the front desks of the Streetlife Museum and Hull and East Riding Museum for anyone who may find it difficult to stand during performances.

Toilets

Relaxed craft sessions

On each event day, a relaxed craft session where children can have a go at the crafts available more widely at the event, but in a quieter environment with limited numbers of people, will take place. This session is designed for people who are disabled, neurodivergent or experience anxiety, who would find it difficult to attend the drop-in craft activities at the event. It takes place at the start of the event day when the event is normally quieter.
