There is Blue Badge parking on Gandhi Way and Alfred Gelder Street. There is a multistory carpark and also a short stay cash only pay and display on Lowgate.

Minibus parking is available outside by calling 01482 616661.

The nearest bus stops (165m away) are on Alfred Gelder Street (routes 173,3,14,82 and in the other direction 8, 56, 57,173, X7).

Hull Railways station is 0.8 miles/1.3km away.



There is level access to the ground floor galleries.

There is a lift to the first floor galleries at the far end of the streetscene.



Assistance dogs are welcome




Audio description (through a QR code) and braille are available for the Invacar display.





There is an Induction loop at the front desk/shop and a portable one is available for events.




BSL interpretation is available for talks and tours

 **WC** Accessible Toilets are available at the toilets nearest the entrance and the toilets at the far end of the street scene.

 Baby Change facilities are available in the toilets near the entrance and in the toilets at the far end of the streetscene.

 Our nearest Changing Places Toilet are at the Guildhall (300m away) and Trinity Market (500m away)

Please note;

- High Street is a cobbled street. There is an accessible route map available on our website
- There is low lighting in the carriage gallery and bicycle gallery upstairs.
- Streetlife museum has a recreated street scene inside with cobbled flooring.
- Some parts of the museum are only accessible via steps, such as the signal box and the platform above the train.
