

Spurn Lightship – Quick Access Guide

 There is a short stay pay and display carpark on the Marina including blue badge spaces.

Princes Quay and Fruit Market multi-story carparks are within a 3 minute walk.

The nearest bus stop is Monument Bridge. Buses from here take you to the train station.

Hull Railway station is a 20 minute walk or 1.2 miles/2km away.

Taxis can drop off on Railway Street.



There is level access to the deck via a gangway.

The deck slopes and can be slippery during wet or icy weather.

There is no lift to the lower decks, access is by steep ladders. The doorways below deck have high doorframes to step over.

A film showing the history of the ship can be viewed from a wooden cabin on the top deck.

- The doors to this room are 87cm at their widest.

- The room is 150cm wide by 230cm long.



Assistance dogs are welcome on the deck but will not be able to access the lower deck due to ladders and steps.



The film on deck has BSL and subtitles.



^{WC} An Accessible Toilet is available at the Holiday Inn Hull Marina for Spurn Lightship visitors.

The nearest Changing Places toilet is at Trinity Market, 14 minutes walk away.

Please note;

- Humber Street and Humber Dock Street are cobbled streets.
- There is low lighting in the lower deck.
- The doorways on the lower deck have high thresholds.
- Access below deck is via steep ladders
- Below Deck is a series of enclosed spaces.
