There is Blue Badge parking at City Hall (Paragon Street). The nearest multi-story carpark is Princes Quay.

The nearest bus stops (85m away) are Monument Bridge (routes 121, 60A, 66, PRX, X46 and X55) and Carr Lane (57, 51).

Hull railway station is 0.5km away or a 9 minute walk.



There is a ramp on the right-hand side of the entrance to the museum.

There is level access to the ground floor. There is a lift to the first floor, second floor and basement.



Assistance dogs are welcome.



There is an induction loop at the welcome desk, in the education space and the listening posts.

There are Accessible Toilets on the ground floor and first floor.



There are Baby Change facilities on the ground floor and first floor accessible toilets and the second floor unisex toilet.



There is a Changing Places toilet in the basement, accessible through an intercom.



Our lift is 2m deep x 2m tall x 89cm (this is the door width).



Our narrowest door is 77cm wide (planetarium). Some of our internal doors are 80cm- 92cm wide.
