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Art Tour (Landscapes) outline:

- Introduction to the site and setting the scene to the tour and theme of landscapes
- Guided tour of key artworks (approximately 30-minutes) linked to landscapes
- For inspiration, a demonstration of an art-based skill how artists plan a landscape drawing
- You'll then be encouraged to explore the gallery with your art materials
- Plenary and evaluation.

Post Visit Activity Suggestions

- Create a gallery in school using artworks created linked to your art project in school. Task the pupils with helping to curate the space, including writing individual labels and a collaborative introductory panel.
- Write a biography about an artist whose work you saw on the tour. Aspects of the biography could include writing about their life, their work and influences and other artists who work in the same style.
- Explore how other artists have represented your geographical feature using paint. Some suggestions as starting points might be Coast - Turner, Mountains - Cezanne, Rivers and Waterways - Canaletto, Countryside - Hockney
